- Encourage business ownership and self-employment as a means of economic self-sufficiency

Eligibility for a loan:

- At the time of application and throughout the term of the loan, a business must have its primary office/headquarters or operations within the city limits of Arvada. *Home based businesses are not eligible.*
- There are no restrictions on the type of business eligible for loans so long as the activities of the business are legal and in the best interest of the community.
- A business must file all completed application information and meet program underwriting criteria established by Colorado Enterprise Fund.
